

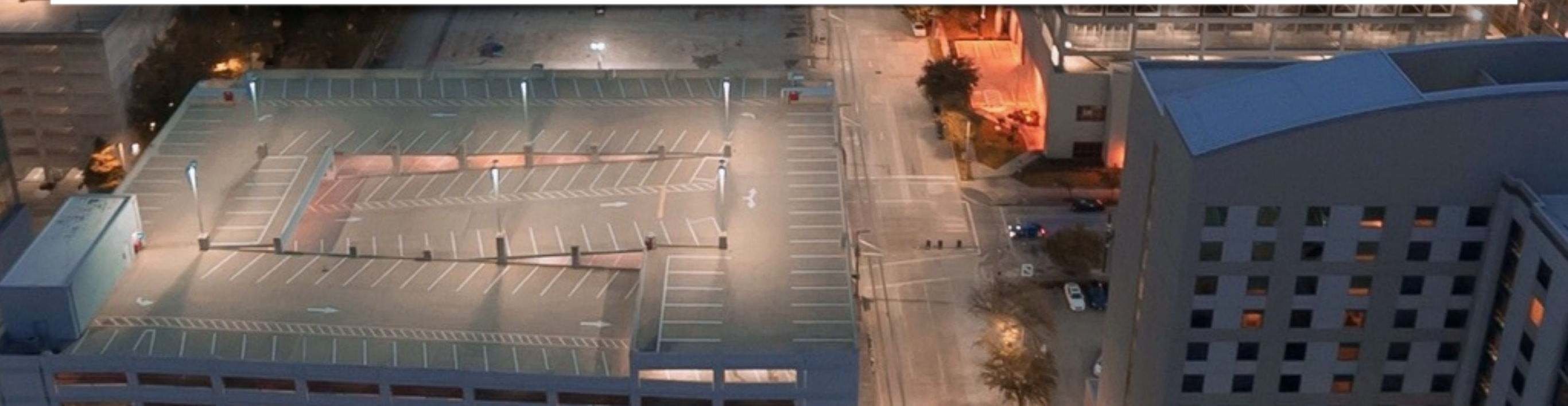


Intern experience at
